California Senate passed SB1000. If you are not familiar, this would require Law Enforcement agencies to restore public access to radio communications. It still needs to be approved by the state assembly before the Governor can sign it. Both CALNENA and the California Police Chiefs Association strongly oppose this bill. They both sent letters to Senator Josh Becker strongly opposing this bill. The economic impact along with added workload to both radio staff and our dispatchers is significant.
